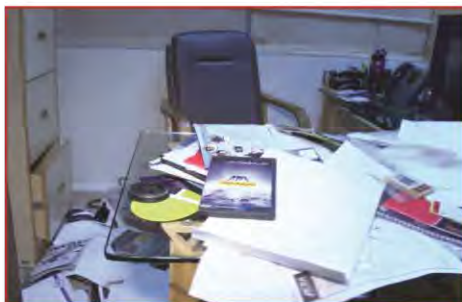
Introduction

This dossier is a compilation of atrocities that began in Pakistan in 2015 and continue till now. The dossier comprises four sections: The rise of Axact and persecution of BOL Media Group, fabricated cases against its Co-Chairman Shoaib Shaikh, illegal arrests and custodial torture of BOL journalists, and how will cruelty be eradicated?

Within this dossier, references, FIRs, photographs, tweets and screenshots of all incidents are annexed. Even at the time of the release of this dossier, the BOL Media Group continue facing victimisation. Hardly a day goes by without attempts by PEMRA to silence BOL TV through cable operators. Illegal cases are posing a question mark on justice as threatening journalists associated with the channel has almost become a routine. The government keeps on violating fundamental human rights to suppress freedom of expression in the country.

1. The Rise of Axact and Persecution of BOL Media Group

In 1997, Axact emerged as a significant player in the Pakistani IT industry. While Google was not yet launched, Axact came up with a mission to promote IT exports in Pakistan and create significant employment opportunities. A mission that was achieved both successfully and quickly by the Company. The goal was to bring IT exports up to a level that would transform the Pakistani economy. Axact aimed to revolutionise Pakistan's IT export base like other developed countries of the world. By 2014, Pakistan's IT exports had touched \$432 million, out of which \$355 million or 82 per cent was contributed by Axact. If the country had been progressing at this pace, Pakistan's annual IT exports would have soared to 3-4 billion dollars by now as per the vision of Shoaib Shaikh. With such a growing influx of foreign exchange every year, there would be no need to beg for loans to keep the country afloat. The IT revolution could have addressed unemployment by creating jobs and reducing poverty. In 2014, Axact employed 15,600 IT professionals, and had the journey continued, the organisation would have provided jobs to over 100,000 people by now.



2. Concocted Cases Against Co-Chairman Shoaib Shaikh

Dark Page of Spite in Country's Media History

It all started when Axact announced bringing BOL Media Group to show the positive side of Pakistan to the world. It was a breath of fresh air in the otherwise corrupt media landscape. One can gauge the popularity of BOL by the fact that it became talk of the town even before the first broadcast. Fed up with traditional media platforms, people were hopeful that BOL would soon become their voice by upholding truth and integrity. Everyone was eagerly waiting its launch, including those who wanted to be a part of the most high-tech media group offering excellent salaries, perks and life style - a dream come true for journalists. Feeling threatened by BOL, all channels ganged up to weave conspiracies and spreading false stories about Axact to bring the group down. Nobody accused Axact of any wrongdoing from the time of its launch in 1997 till 2014 when the evil campaign ventured to derail the project. Axact was bringing in a lot of foreign exchange to the country and that didn't go well with a lot of media groups. Within six hours, BOL's accounts were frozen and nine of its senior officers, including Co-Chairman Shoaib Shaikh, were arrested. Pakistan's largest IT Company, the backbone of its export base, was sealed without delay. The man who saw the dream of revolutionizing the IT sector in Pakistan was handcuffed and put behind bars. One by one, all limits of vindictiveness were crossed. The tormentors claimed that they had set a new record of custodial torture for Shoaib Sheikh. Now they were out to silence BOL so that it could not expose the plot hatched by media groups with the support of the government and its institutions. To achieve this goal, the offices of Axact and BOL TV were raided in the middle of the night, server rooms were set on fire, accounts were frozen and houses and vehicles were sealed. An FIR was filed against Shoaib Shaikh, his mother, wife, and sister. While Shoaib Shaikh was under arrest, a team of 250 policemen, including the Inspector General, ransacked his house in Islamabad. Thousands of the young brightest minds working for Axact and BOL TV were physically and verbally abused and treated like offenders. Their only fault was that they didn't go abroad, worked day and night for the growth of IT and dreamed of a better future and a quality life for their children within this country.



Instead of being honoured for their commitment and loyalty to this country, they were attacked and publicly humiliated and everything was shown live on TV screens. When thousands of workers lost jobs, they started struggling to make ends meet. Their parents and children with teary eyes protested for weeks to reinstate their breadwinners and stop atrocities against Axact and BOL. But the government refused to budge, and there was a barrage of baseless cases against the group and its Chairman.

A barrage of unfounded suits

A case without a complainant, what an iniquity!

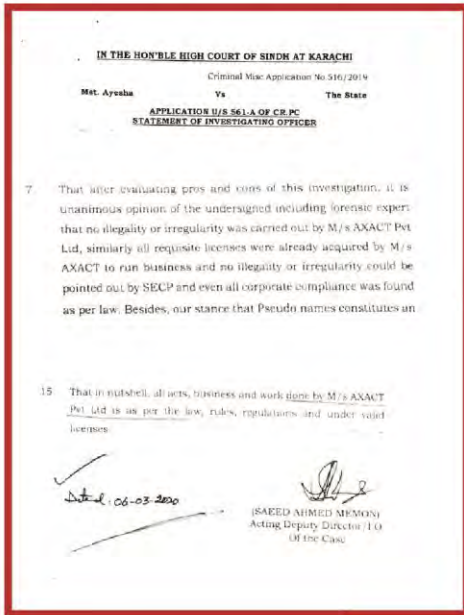
The first fake case against Axact was about fraud without any complainant. There was no claimant or witness behind the fraud allegations against the company. The government itself was the plaintiff and also carried out the investigation. The same fake case with similar allegations was registered simultaneously in Islamabad and Karachi which negates the law. Even the investigating officers admitted openly that it was the same allegation on which two FIRs were registered in clear violation of the rules. Despite the anomaly, Shoaib Shaikh, the owner of the largest IT Company and a TV channel, remained in jail for 18 months without getting bail in an otherwiseailable case. Since charges could not be proved, Islamabad court in 2016 exonerated Shoaib Sheikh. 60 days were given to appeal against the acquittal but not a single application was submitted. Surprisingly, an appeal was filed after the passage of 102 days, 42 days after the deadline, and was accepted.



A total of nine judges heard the case in Sindh High Court, but each one would withdraw at the end saying Not Before Me. Each time, Shaikh was presented in court handcuffed and face covered as if it was a terrorism case, but this only exposed the real face of the oppressors.

After a year and a half, he was finally released on bail, but the baseless case was still intact. Finally, after eight years, the judge acquitted Shaikh in a packed Sindh High Court. This proved that all the allegations were baseless and without merit. It was clear that the first case against Axact was based on lies and bias from the very beginning.

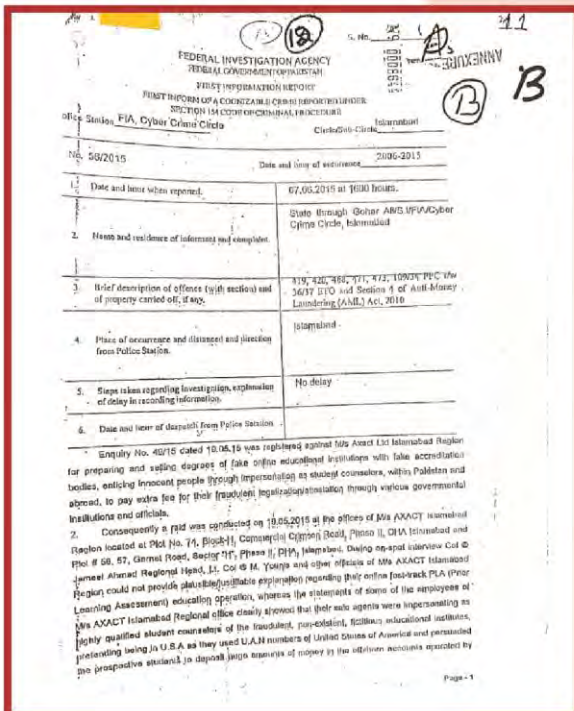

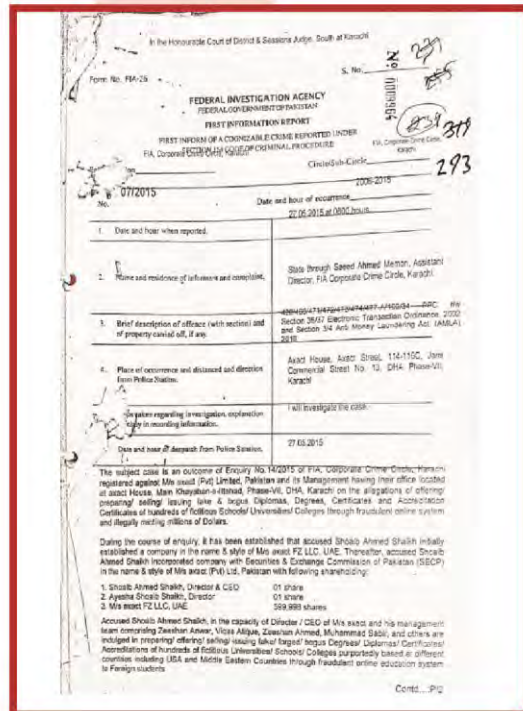

ISB CASE APPEAL

False allegation of bribery without any evidence

In another case, Shoaib Shaikh was accused of bribery without any evidence. The judge, who had previously acquitted Shoaib Shaikh from the case, was accused by a fellow judge of taking a bribe from a brigadier. Again, there was no proof and no one came forward to support this baseless allegation. The FIA did not even name the brigadier and eventually the charge was dropped, but the case remained unresolved. The investigating officer and plaintiff in the case admitted that all the actions taken by the company were legally permissible. He went on to say that Axtact is a reputable IT company that has not engaged in any fraudulent activities. Shoaib Shaikh appealed for acquittal, but the judge ordered another trial to be conducted.

Upon receipt of a reference from Addl. Registrar of Hon'ble Islamabad High Court dated 17.02.2018, an Enquiry No 08/2018 was registered at FIA Anti-Corruption Circle, Islamabad. Consequent upon of said enquiry, it transpired that Pervaiz-ul-Qadir Memon, Ex-Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Islamabad has admittedly received illegal gratification amounting Rs. 05 million for the acquittal of Shoaib Ahmed Sheikh, CEO Axtact in case titled as "The State Vs. Shoaib Ahmed Sheikh" vide his judgement dated 31.10.2016 in case FIR No. 56/2015 of PS FIA Cyber Crime Circle, Islamabad. This, prima facie, constitutes offences of misuse of authority for illegal personal gains and criminal misconduct. Hence, after approval from competent authority, a case is registered against (1) Parvez-ul-Qadir Memon, Ex-ADSI on the charges of taking illegal gratification for acquitting Shoaib Ahmed Shaikh through judgment dated 31.10.2016 and (2) Shoaib Ahmed Shaikh, CEO Axtact for being beneficiary of the said transaction under w/s 161, 165-A, 109 PPC and 5(2) PCA 1947. Copies of FIR are being sent to quarters concerned.

BOGUS FIR ON CORRUPTION CHARGES

Foreign exchange regulation case, a ridiculous charge of money laundering

When the above false cases did not lead to a satisfactory outcome, another case was fabricated out of fear of the release of Co-Chairman Shoaib Shaikh. A ridiculous allegation was made under the Foreign Exchange Regulatory Act (FERA) that a million rupees were sent out of Pakistan through an illegal Hundi channel. Why would a company that was bringing in 355 million dollars to Pakistan through IT exports, send a few lakh rupees through Hundi?

Furthermore, this case does not even apply to the accused, as another party who received the cheque as payment sent the money on his own.

FBR case

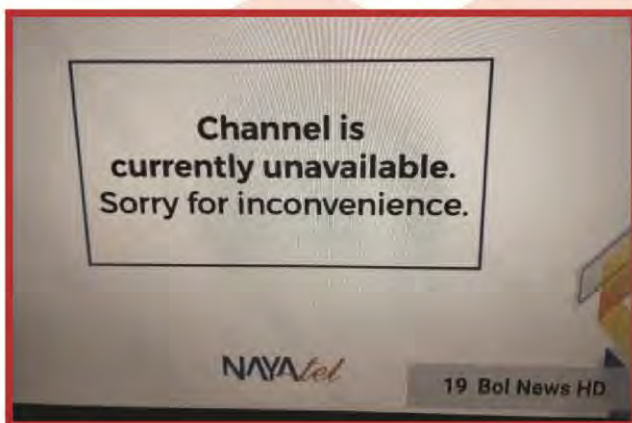
When Axaact asked the Federal Board of Revenue for its legitimate tax refund, the board opened up an audit of the Company. As per the rules, there is no tax applied on IT exports from Pakistan, and the advertising revenue that BOL Media receives is already tax deducted before the amount is received. The organisation has been paying billions of rupees in withholding tax every year and asking for a refund became a crime and laid the foundation of another baseless case against the company.

Customs Document Case

A case was filed with customs claiming that the broadcasting equipment was brought in duty-free by BOL TV. Firstly, these equipment are exempt from duty, when the required documents for the equipment were provided, the case was not closed, leaving it to be reopened after five years to continue persecution. In February 2023, FIA and Customs officials raided BOL TV's office under the same false pretext, attempting to stop transmissions of the most popular channel in the country. The employees were manhandled and humiliated for no reason. The same invoices shared eight years ago were demanded to be produced again. Even the equipment in question had completed its life and was not in use anymore. The purpose of this attack on a leading TV channel and the harassment of its employees was nothing but to increase pressure and silence the voice of truth.

The Cruelty of Pemra

Pemra has surpassed all limits of oppression, an unprecedented act in history. Since its inception, BOL's broadcast has been stopped 102 times without any notice. What kind of hostility could lead the government to suppress news for the public? It seems like a child's play to close down the channel on the orders of Pemra. Each time, the channel was shut down without any prior notice which defies the rules. Pemra exerted all kinds of pressure on BOL, including illegal closures. Cable operators were contacted and threatened with dire consequences if they aired BOL's content. This way, Pemra joined the list of state institutes like FIA, FBR, Customs and Excise, whose sole target was attacking BOL Media Group. The sole reason behind all this exercise was to attack BOL's reporters, bureau chiefs, and anchors, but BOL stood by its staff.



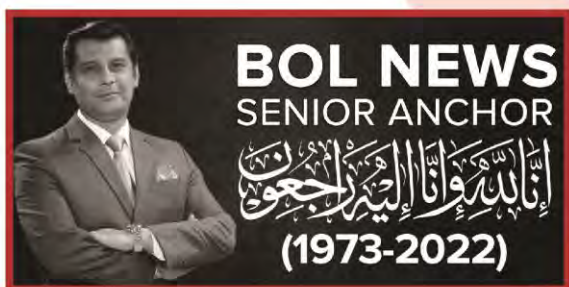
3. Extrajudicial arrest and torture of journalists working for BOL

Arshad Sharif

On October 23, 2022, Pakistani journalism experienced its darkest day in history. Arshad Sharif, a well-known anchor of the world-renowned BOL news network and an acclaimed investigative journalist, was targeted in Kenya, where he had gone due to threats to his life. Two months prior, state repression and arrest had forced him to leave Pakistan. Arshad Sharif had exposed those who wore the cloak of lies and hypocrisy while disrespecting democracy and humanity. Despite facing baseless FIRs and being taken off the air, he did not back down from his position. Government repression ultimately forced him to leave the country. When Arshad Sharif was in Dubai, he faced pressure to leave again, after which he went to Kenya and was killed there.

Arshad Sharif was a top journalist in Pakistan, whose martyrdom caused an uproar around the world. However, the rulers remained silent on this cruel act. Arshad Sharif's father and brother also sacrificed their lives for the country. He was a capable, fearless, and brave journalist whose truthfulness earned him the status of martyrdom.

Despite several months having passed, the investigation into the atrocities committed against Arshad Sharif Shaheed has yet to be completed. BOL news network has always stood by its journalists and will continue to do so. After the martyrdom of Arshad Sharif, the Supreme Court took notice of his murder case as a result of BOL News' efforts. Any progress made in this case so far is a result of BOL News' hard work and commitment to true journalism. No matter how many obstacles or atrocities the rulers erect, the word of truth will not be silenced.



Sami Ibrahim

The government has gone to great lengths to silence the truth, but the voice of truth is intact. The government's tactics have failed to suppress the freedom of speech. All the cases made against BOL journalists to stifle free speech have turned out to be empty and insubstantial. Sami Ibrahim, a journalist with BOL News, is also a fearless voice that brings the truth to the public in all circumstances. He exposes the government's propaganda and speaks out against injustice done to the people. However, this journalist of BOL News has also had to pay the price. For the crime of telling the truth, false cases were made against him for which he was attacked and beaten. A defamation case was registered against Sami Ibrahim in Quetta, Qila Abdullah, and Pashin under Sections 34, 131, 153A, 499, and 505 of the Pakistan Penal Code.

The government could not tolerate the bitter truth of a video made by Sami Ibrahim, and as a result, unknown persons attacked him outside the office of BOL News in Islamabad. According to Sami Ibrahim, the unknown persons who attacked him arrived in a car with a green number plate. The ruler has gone to extreme lengths to restrict freedom of the press, but BOL News has stood by its journalists. Whenever Sami Ibrahim and other journalists have faced hard times or been forced to pay the price for speaking the truth, BOL News has become a concrete wall for its journalists, because BOL News is the voice of truth and truth cannot be suppressed under any circumstances.

Imran Riaz Khan

BOL News has faced numerous challenges throughout its existence for being the voice of truth and justice. In the past, the news channel has been removed from cable networks and journalists have been threatened. Some journalists have even been abducted from their homes, while others were taken hostage from the office. Despite these obstacles, BOL News remained steadfast in its mission to report the truth. However, after the success of a no-confidence vote in April, the PDM government targeted BOL News. BOL News journalist Arshad Sharif was deported from Kenya for an unknown crime, and was later found dead. In addition, several other journalists, including Sami Ibrahim, Imran Riaz Khan, Jameel Farooqui, and Siddique Jan, were arrested on baseless charges. Imran Riaz Khan, a senior anchor at BOL News, was arrested on July 5, 2022, while on his way to Islamabad after joining BOL News in a sedition case registered in Attock. Khan's lawyer, Mian Ali Ashfaq, confirmed his arrest. Seventeen sedition cases were registered against Khan across Punjab, with two in Gujra, one in Muzaffargarh, and one in Jhang. These cases were filed under various sections of the Pakistan Penal Code and the Prevention of Electronic Crime Act 2016. One of the cases against Khan was filed by Riaz-ul-Haq, the brother of Major Zack-ul-Haq Shaheed, under sections 109, 501-C1, 503, and 505 of the Pakistan Penal Code. It was alleged that Khan's allegations had damaged the reputation of the army. Another case was registered against Khan at the Dhajiji police station in Thatta under sections 131, 153, 452, and 505 of the Pakistan Penal Code, relating to sedition and incitement to public disorder. Khan was produced in the Lahore High Court on July 9, where he was granted bail on the petition filed against his arrest. The hearing was adjourned until July 19. Later that night, the Islamabad High Court summoned the authorised officer at 10 am on behalf of the IG Islamabad on the contempt of court petition filed on the arrest of Khan. The local court reserved its verdict at 3:00 pm and announced the verdict around 7:00 pm, ordering the immediate release of Imran Riaz. The judge stated that the accusations against Khan were baseless and acquitted him of the charges. His, thus, justice prevailed, and BOL's attackers were once again defeated.

Jameel Farooqui

The government has been suppressing media freedom and making every effort to prevent BOL from reporting the truth. They have fabricated false cases against BOL journalists and subjected them to arrests, torture, and harassment. In some cases, the broadcast of their reports has been banned.

On August 22, 2022, a bizarre and troubling incident occurred when BOL anchor Jameel Farooqui was illegally arrested from Karachi in the dead of night. He was accused of verbally abusing the Islamabad police. What made the situation even more surprising was that he was arrested from Karachi, but the Sindh Police remained unaware of the arrest. Zahid Lodhi, SHO of Zaman Town, confirmed that the local police did not arrest Jameel Farooqui. BOL TV reporter Kamran Minhas informed the Sindh Police that Jameel Farooqui had left the channel building in Korangi on Saturday night and had gone missing. Lodhi was unaware of this and stated that Farooqui had not been detained by the police or any member of his team.

The mystery was later solved by a tweet from the Islamabad Police, which stated that a case against Jameel Farooqui for making false allegations against the Islamabad Capital Police was registered at 22/701 Ramna Police Station. However, shortly after, the Islamabad Police deleted the tweet from their account.

The cruelty did not end with the baseless FIR against Farooqui. His family members were also kept in the dark about his illegal arrest. Farooqui was subjected to the worst torture and inhumane treatment to intimidate him. A video of a policeman slapping and pushing him was released. On August 31, 2022, Jameel Farooqui was released on bail after enduring the worst form of cruelty in jail. Once again, the truth triumphed over the government's attempts to silence BOL News. After each atcity, the popularity of BOL continues to increase.

FIR AGAINST JAMEEL FAROOQUI

Siddique Jan

BOL News has been a target for speaking the truth and standing up for it, and it has faced repercussions throughout history. Despite being removed from the cable and facing threats, BOL News continued to speak up for the truth. However, things took a turn for the worse after the success of the no-confidence vote in April, when the PDM government attacked BOL News. BOL News journalist Arshad Sharif was deported to Kenya for an unknown crime, where he was killed. Furthermore, Sami Ibrahim, Imran Riaz Khan, Jameel Farooqui, and Siddique Jan were arrested on baseless charges. Siddique Jan, the bureau of BOL News Islamabad, was arrested outside the BOL News Islamabad office by plain cloth officers on March 20. CCTV footage of the arrest was later revealed. On March 18, Siddique Jan was arrested by Islamabad Capital Police on charges of causing tension in the judicial complex during the hearing of Imran Khan's Tosha Khana case. The Islamabad Police registered a case against Imran Khan and others at CTD Police Station under sections of terrorism and other provisions for the tension outside the Federal Judicial Complex. On March 22, Siddique Jan was produced in court after a one-day remand. During the hearing, the Islamabad police asked for another 5-day remand, which angered the court. The court expressed its dissatisfaction with the police's behaviour and clarified the difference between a journalist and a terrorist. The investigating officer wanted to take Siddique Jan to Lahore, but the judge ordered his release after Siddique Jan deposited a bond of 50,000. The truth remained victorious after the failure of false cases against Imran Riaz, Sami Ibrahim, and Jameel Farooqui. Despite facing these challenges, BOL News remained steadfast in its commitment to reporting truth and justice.



How will cruelty be eradicated?

There are only two ways:

1. Just court decisions
2. Public standing up against oppression

Fabricated cases against Shoaib Shaikh

When a fraud case was filed against Shoaib Shaikh, the judiciary should have asked who the victim of the fraud was. Upon hearing that no fraud had been committed, the case could have easily been dismissed and the injustice would have been eradicated.

Two FIRs filed for a single accusation.

In two different cities, two FIRs were registered on the same charges. This does not fall within the scope of the law. Had it been questioned as to why two FIRs were filed separately for a single incident, the injustice could have been stopped.

Shoaib Ahmad Shaikh acquitted in Islamabad

An appeal against the acquittal was filed 42 days after the expiry of the deadline and was surprisingly granted. Had the appeal was not accepted, the cruelty would have ended automatically.

False case of bribing a judge

Shoaib Shaikh was acquitted in a crowded courtroom. However, after two and a half hours, the judge issued a 'not before me' verdict, effectively overturning the earlier decision. If judges had not engaged in such behaviour and stick to their original decision, injustice could have been prevented.

Replacement of Shoaib Shaikh's Judge

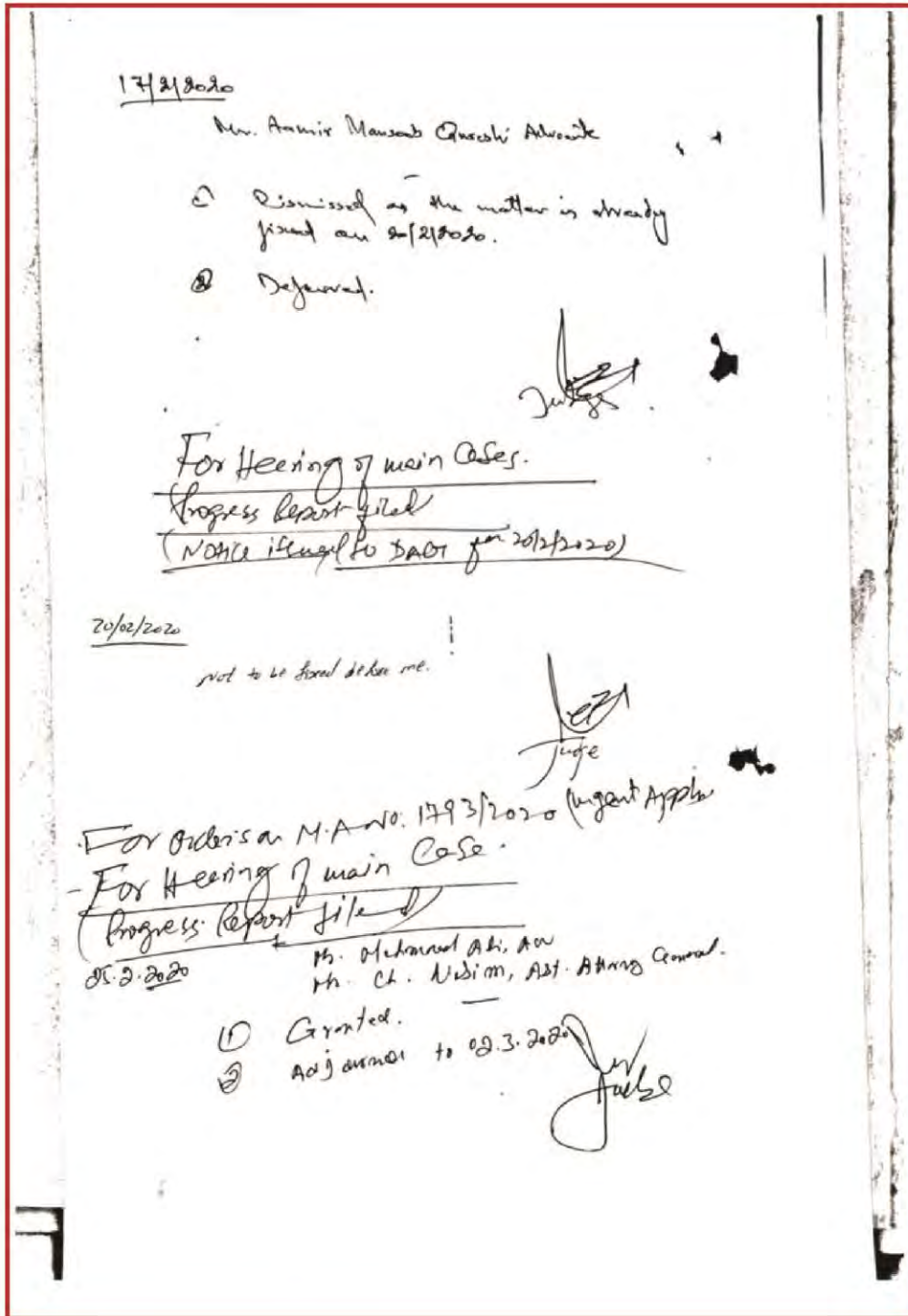
A judge can either recuse himself from a case or be removed by the Chief Justice of the Islamabad High Court. Even though neither of these two things happened, the judge was replaced. It is unclear why the judge was replaced without asking to be removed or being removed by the Chief Justice of the Islamabad High Court. If it didn't happen, oppression would have ended.

Closure of BOL News

The Chairman of PEMRA (Pakistan Electronic Media Regulatory Authority) cannot legally shut down a television channel. However, BOL News was shut down 102 times, which is a record in the history of the country's television industry. No notice or message was given before the channel was closed. The closure was later challenged in court. If the Chairman of PEMRA had addressed the issue at the time, the channel would not have been closed again and injustice could have been prevented.

Shoaib Shaikh was acquitted in a crowded courtroom. However, after two and a half hours, the judge issued a 'not before me' verdict, effectively overturning the earlier decision. If judges had not engaged in such behaviour and stick to their original decision, injustice could have been prevented.

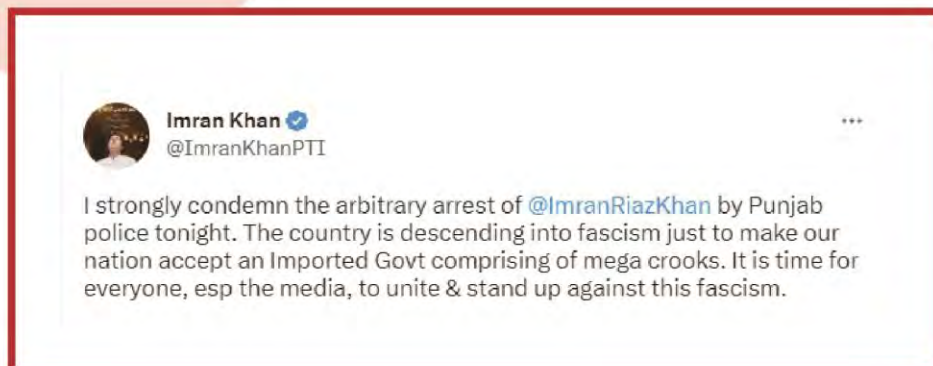
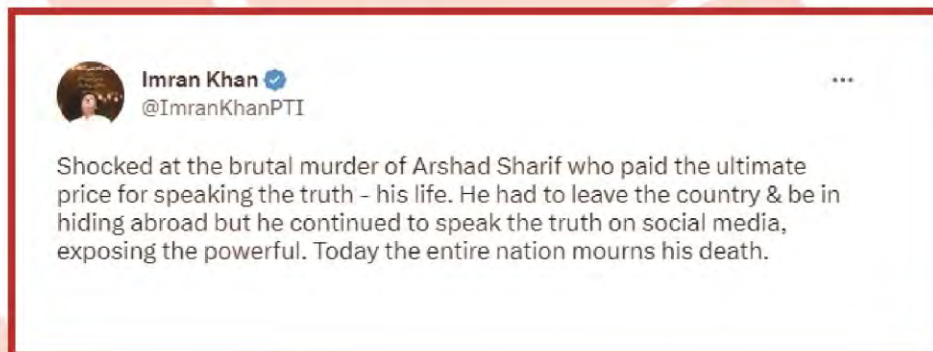
Buyer of Equipment and Customs Case

Despite having all the necessary documents for the purchase of the equipment, a raid was conducted. Furthermore, instead of closing the case, it was reopened five years later. If the judiciary had questioned how and why the case was closed and then reopened, the truth would have been revealed.

Concluding words

The persecution of the Axact is not just limited to four cases, but it represents a larger attempt to suppress the truth. Shoaib Shaikh's name is not on the Exit Control List (ECL) but despite all difficulties, he never stepped out of Pakistan for even a single day. He has no plan to leave the country in future as well. According to Shaikh, he will continue resisting all kinds of oppression and will stand for truth and justice. Long live Pakistan.
